Service Fees

SERVICE	COST	PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS
Intake Fee <i>(inclusive of any screening conducted)</i>	\$100.00	To be paid on the date of service delivery
Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Evaluation Fee	\$275.00	To be paid prior to scheduling the evaluation
Client Fee	\$70.00	To be paid at the time of intake. Payable only via money order or certified bank check. Payable to "Treasurer, State of NH"
Impaired Driver Education Program (IDEP or WIDEP) Fee	\$400.00	A deposit of \$200.00 is required to hold a space on a class roster. The balance is due by the end of the program
Case Management Fees	\$20.00 per week for the duration of the Service Plan	Payment is to be made in a manner as determined by the IDCMP. Maximum \$80.00 per month
Court Proceeding Fees: <i>For each day that an IDCMP staff member is required to attend a sentencing court proceeding as a result of a notice of non-compliance being sent in accordance with He-A 507.06 (i) and (m)</i>	\$130.00 per day	Payment is to be made in a manner as determined by the IDCMP.
Drug or Alcohol Testing Fees: <i>If required by the service plan</i>	Varies	To be paid directly to the testing site
Out of State Administrative Fees: <i>For clients that live out of state, and had a New Hampshire offense, but want to complete the program in the state that they are currently residing</i>	\$350.00	To be paid at the time of intake.
Out of State/Out of State Administrative Fees: <i>For clients that live out of state and the offense occurred out of state</i>	\$800.00	To be paid at the time of intake.
Missed Appointment Fee <i>For clients who do not attend or arrive more than 15 minutes late to any appointment (intake, class, or evaluation). All clients who arrive more than 15 minutes late will be required to reschedule</i>	\$100.00	To be paid by the end of the program
